Tuscola County Courthouse

Vital Records from the Tuscola County Courthouse **must be obtained from the Courthouse.** They have Marriage, death, divorce, probate, and land records of Tuscola County 1867 to the present. Birth records are closed by Michigan Public Act 161– in order to get a birth record you must prove ancestry by document if the certificate is under 100 years old. **You must request birth records yourself** from the Tuscola County Clerk's Office—we cannot do this for you. Hours are Monday—Friday 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.
