## What is Homebound Service?

Free monthly delivery is provided to anyone who lives in the Caro Area Library District and is homebound due to temporary or permanent illness or disability, or is unable to visit the library.

- Caro Area District Library staff will bring or return items to you.
- Reading, listening and viewing materials may be requested.
- No fines are charged for overdue items, but patrons are responsible for lost or damaged items.
- We can bring a library card application for you to sign for this service (as long as you have a valid ID).
