We will provide pizza, an escape room, video games, board games, and more. The teens are required to bring their own drinks. The participants will not be able to leave the library until 7:00am Saturday morning, except in the case of an emergency or illness.

My parents/legal guardian and I understand that if there are any issues with my behavior the library staff may contact my parent/legal guardian to pick me up at any time during the lock-in.
